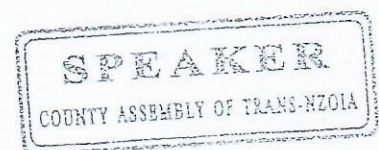

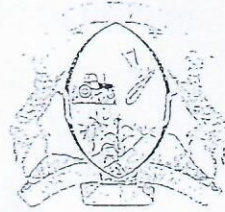

Mr. Speaker Sir,

Aware that, some offices in the lands department that is planning and survey were closed down locking out officers in the said offices on or about February 2023 by the CECM lands on allegations of corruption

Further aware, the said offices have since remained closed for more than two quarters of the year with no explanation

Concerned that the said officers have not been formerly charged and or faced any disciplinary actions for their alleged misconduct

Mr Speaker Sir, the said officers are drawing salaries from the public coffers despite not working and no visible action have been taken by the department or any concerned party

Deeply concerned that, these officers in the said closed offices play a crucial role in the discharge of the functions of the department including plans approval, land transfers and subdivisions which are a big revenue stream for the County and which have since been paralyzed;

Mr. Speaker Sir could the CECM lands, Housing, planning and physical development furnish this house on information on.

- 1) The basis for the locking of the offices and locking out the officers.
- 2) The form of disengagement of the officers and the duration of the disengagement.
- 3) The officers who have been in charge of plan approvals in the absence of the County Planners.
- 4) Any findings on any investigations done for or against the said officers.
- 5) The plans the department has in opening up the said offices and plans on the re engagement of the officers.

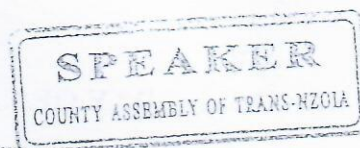
